The recipients will have demonstrated individual initiative, creativity, responsibility, cooperation, citizenship and leadership through their involvement in programs and services that positively influence fellow students and have contributed to the college community.

Selection Process:

The nominating party should fill out the application on behalf of the candidate and return it to the Center for Student Involvement by April 8, 2011.
