## Instructions:

1. Apply for admission to ESU or be currently enrolled at ESU.
2. Fill out this application form completely.
3. Write an essay on the following topic: "What are the three most important characteristics of an effective teacher?" The essay must be 500 to 750 words in length and typed.
4. Provide two letters of reference. One should be from a teacher or professor and the other should be from an individual who can describe qualities that will contribute to your success as a teacher (high school counselor, principal, etc.). If you are a current ESU student, both letters may be written by ESU faculty members.
5. Submit your official academic transcript. Incoming freshmen transcripts should include your cumulative GPA, class rank, and class size.
6. Freshmen only: Submit your official ACT scores ONLY if your ACT score does not appear on your high school transcript.
