The scholarship will be equal to current undergraduate **in-state** tuition and fees, the current Residence Hall fees (double room) including the full meal plan, and the current average cost of books for a full-time student in good academic standing. Prior recipients may reapply. Application is open to undergraduate and graduate students.

Each applicant **must**:

*Submit an essay on the importance of this scholarship in completing the student's educational goals

*Submit transcripts

-Incoming freshman students must send official high school transcripts

-Incoming transfer students must send official transcripts from all colleges attended

-Current ESU students may submit an unofficial Buzz-In transcript

*This scholarship award process may include an interview with the Scholarship Committee
